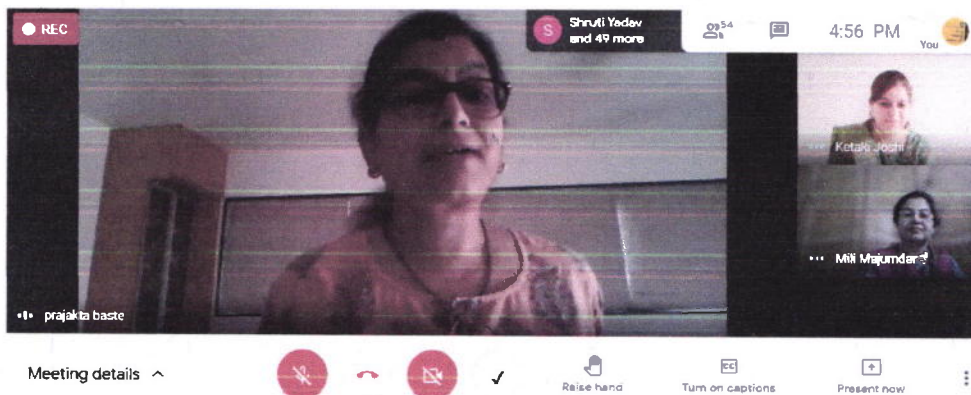

Brief about the (Activity/Event)	<p>A Seminar was organised by our college on Hospital Design for third year students. The programme was started with the Guidance to students for Seminar by Prof. Arpita Bhatt.</p> <p>Principal Dr. Prajakta Baste introduced the Seminar.</p> <p>Dr. Nilangi Sardeshpande gave an insightful presentation to help students in their design process.</p> <p>Dr. Nilangi explained how medical practice has changed from single handed practice to specialty to multispecialty to super specialty hospital and accordingly how allied setup has evolved. Also she touched upon who all are part of the caregiving after doctors to understand how allied staff also plays a role to run the hospital.</p> <p>Very important fact that Dr. Nilangi brought in was, how different patients get admitted into hospital differently, and explained how OPD, IPD, consulting rooms, waiting area outside operation theatre, ICU,OT Complex, Prayer room ,Rest rooms for doctors that gave very clear idea about how we as a designer should design spaces by understanding the users ,purpose and functions. At outset, it was a thoroughly informative session with a totally different perspective to design a space which can architecturally heal humankind.</p> <p>Ar. Milind Kulkarni with his presentation explained how to do horizontal as well as vertical zoning. Services, which is the very important and critical part of the hospital, also explained taking into consideration the height of the floor, structural grid, options like flat slab, inverted beams etc.</p> <p>He also shared his drawings to understand the complexity of service layouts.</p> <p>Ar. Dinesh Bhamre, through his projects, explained the layouts of hospitals. He also explained the requirements of each and every area with respect to services and segregations.</p>

Harmandir Sahib, as a monument, has a rich history of its own; it is the monument around which an entire religion, followed by approximately 64% of the world, has developed. The garden is located between the Langar Sahib and the main place of worship. Much like the precinct of Harmandir Sahib, it was important that the garden embodied the idea of accessibility; it needed to become a space with the ability to provide multiple experiences.

VERTICAL LANDSCAPE



Vertical landscapes are areas of vegetation growing directly on the facade of a building or on separate structural systems; they are usually made up of modular units, vegetated mats, or trellises attached to structural walls or frames. In general, they are vertical planting systems used on the inside walls or on the exteriors of buildings. They are irrigated by either closed or open drainage systems to minimize water consumption.

Vertical landscapes are aesthetically pleasing and sustainable, and they contribute to the greening of urban settings by utilizing vertical surfaces. They enhance built-up commercial and office areas, parks and public facilities, educational and health-care buildings, and retail shopping areas, and they also bring additional color to eco-friendly buildings and their surroundings.

SUSTAINABLE LANDSCAPING

A sustainable landscape is one that conforms to the environment surrounding it, requiring only inputs (e.g. water, fertilizer) that are naturally available, with little or no additional support. It is self-sustaining over long periods of time. It exists in harmony with its local ecosystem if bad weather hits, or wildfires or rockslides devastate your neighborhood, your garden recovers quickly.



The landscape is diverse enough to remain resilient and productive indefinitely. When evaluating your landscape for sustainability, there are three main areas to consider: How it responds to the local ecology (ecological), how much it costs to maintain (economic), and how it affects your family and neighbors (socio-cultural).

Arch from Washington University, St. Louis, Missouri, U.S.A. and Masters in Landscape architecture from University of Pennsylvania, U.S.A.

Development plans of Ayodhya Ghats, Master planning and Site development for Rabindra Sarovar, Andrews Gant, Housing for MUDCO - Urban design and landscaping with Design of MID works. NEED OF PROJECT

These Parks will provide vital opportunities for contemplation and enjoyment of nature and scenery, for organized sports and spontaneous play, for civic, ritual and cultural events, and for education and research.

1. As site has immediate road access on two sides
2. Existing vegetation forms a buffer from the road fronts and will play an important shading device

DESIGN SOLUTION

Brief about the Program (Activity/Event)

Every year workshop topics are identified to value add the course curriculum under various subjects. Efforts are taken to call the experts from the field to conduct the workshop. Activities based on the workshop learnings such as assignments, analytical studies, field visits, surveys etc. those are needed to achieve the workshop outcomes, are undertaken during lectures allotted for institute philosophy for the respective year which are over and above the stipulated time for the respective subject conduct. The workshop on streets for people was conducted by 'Institute for Transportation and Development Policy (ITDP), India' for fourth year B. Arch students, subject of Research in Architecture, under the Institute Philosophy – "Learning by Doing". The workshop was conducted in composite manner with partial conduction by expert and partial conduction at institute level under the guidance of core faculty. It is a step towards the betterment of Indian Urban streets by designing them to encourage non-motorized and public transport by meticulously analyzing the patterns of street usage by people in response to factors like availability of footpaths, shading on streets, lighting provisions, vehicle speed, amenities, safety, user friendliness and many more. Students surveyed the identified main streets within the Nashik city and mapped the observations. After analyzing the same, street design proposals were generated under five parameters of walkability, parking, footpaths, crowd streets mapping and building use. ITDP being an advisory body for the local authorities, the proposals thus generated are aimed to be presented to the Municipal Corporation, Nashik in the form of street design guidelines for further development and execution. The work was also exhibited at various locations for public by Lokmat Nashik First.
