

#### **Design Brief:**

#### Background

Water, Amenities and Sanitation Services Upgrading Programme (WASSUP) – is a community organization that repairs and maintains communal toilet facilities in the township of Diepsloot, South Africa.

Objective of developing a free style design is to provide solution to upgrade the existing community toilet facility which is durable and maintenance free. The solution will be easy to install and maintain for local residents across Diepsloot.



#### **Existing Toilets**

Each existing toilet unit comprises of a precast concrete module that houses a water closet and a hand wash and washing facility on the external side of the module. These toilets are located close to the residential area, with its back towards housing and the front facing the street. The toilet units are generally installed in pairs. The water supply and drainage lines are just behind the toilet units. The concept of upgrade is to introduce an improved design which can then for future toilet installations.
