Brief about the (Activity/Event)	<p>This year, the first-year architecture Rural settlement study was a pure Literature study. In the literature study, Students first analysed the settlement of various regions of India belonging to the different climatic zones like Leh Ladakh, Kutch, Villages from the North East part of India, Houses of Nagaland, Agraharas of South India, Kath Khuni Houses of Himachal Pradesh, Banglas of West Bengal, Havelis of Rajasthan, The Pol of Gujarat, Nalukettu of Kerala, Chawls of Mumbai, Wadas of Maharashtra and Chettinad Houses based upon the Socio- cultural background, Lifestyle, local construction techniques and materials. The architectural planning that evolved from the culture and occupational needs responded to the various climatic conditions was crucial to understand. Students studied the four settlements in Daman, Manali, Barmer and Goa exhibiting the different Climatic and geographical conditions. The settlements and residences in them were analysed on various parameters like climate, culture, demographics, construction style, materials, spatial Characteristics etc.</p> <p>All the four settlements that they studied had a diverse culture, context, topography, climate conditions, occupation, and architecture and so on, making them unique and different from everyday lives of our urban living.</p>
Remarks	<p>Due to the Covid Situation, students were unable to do the physical case study. Yet they comprehended the literature study very well. The analysis part was well delivered to the students as it was reflected into their work.</p>

Brief about the (Activity/Event)	<p>This year, the second-year architecture settlement study tour was taken to Mohadi, Nashik. The students documented the settlement of Mohadi, by understanding the local construction techniques and materials.</p> <p>Students were divided into groups and were asked to measure the houses and clusters along with public spaces like streets, chowks, temples and other community areas. Students got to learn about the socio- cultural life of the village and its reflection in the overall architectural planning along with the impact of local climatic conditions.</p> <p>Locally available stone and raw wooden logs largely govern architecture of the region. The old structures dominated the architecture of the village. The livelihood of the people was dependent on their everyday activities including few of the community run business like pottery and chulha making, cottage food industry such as pickles and papad making.</p> <p>Students were able to interact with the locals, understand their routine, the overall lifestyle and their needs. Students were fortunate to document few of the old structures which stood the testimony of time.</p>
Remarks	<p>Due to Covid restrictions, very less students were present for the field visit. Rest others did the literature case studies. Though conducting architectural site visit in the pandemic was a major challenge, yet it proved helpful and kept the enthusiasm of students high.</p>

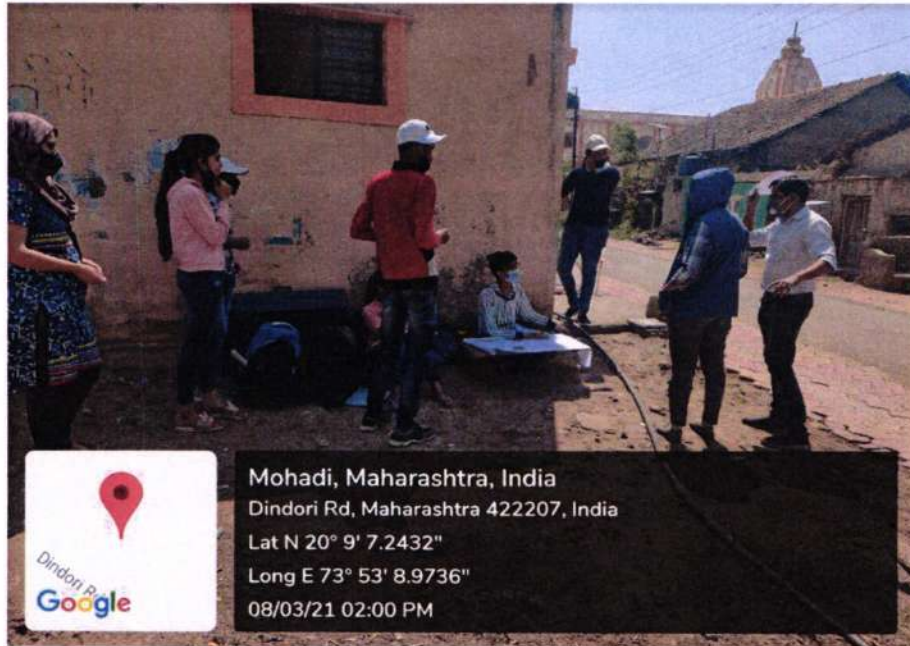

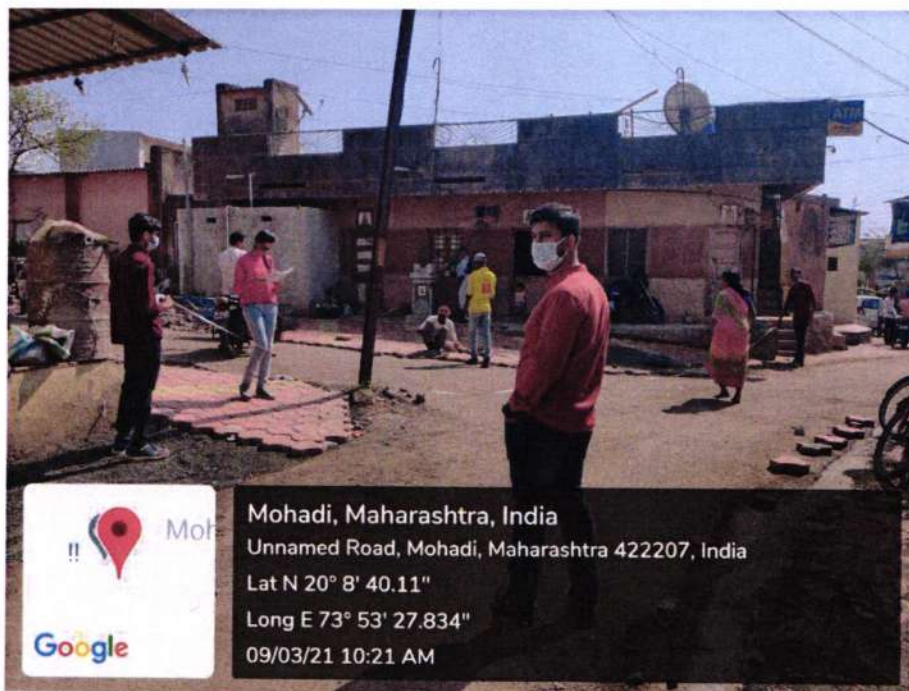

Brief about the (Activity/Event)	<p>This year, the second year architecture settlement study tour was taken to Pochampally weaver's town in Telangana. The students documented the settlement of Pochampally, understanding the local construction techniques and materials. The architectural planning evolved from culture and occupational needs responded to hot and dry climatic conditions was crucial to understand.</p> <p>The students measured important weaver's houses and clusters along with public spaces like streets, chowks. Locally available stone and raw wooden logs largely govern architecture of the region. The weaving looms form integral part of the weaver's house which function as artisanal workshops also. The famous handloom fabric of Pochampally has a lot of demand. The owners have set up small scale handloom factories within the town, which suits weaver's families for flexible working hours. Most of the owners have set up their own outlets on the main street. This benefits both owners and weavers; however, the part commercialisation has lost the character and charm of the town.</p> <p>Students also visited few contemporary structures like mahaprasthanam crematorium, few schools designed by award winning architects and qutubshahi heritage complex.</p>
Remarks	<p>More nearby clusters of weaving could have been explored for richer content. Architectural visits aligned with their design case studies proved helpful and kept the enthusiasm of students high.</p>

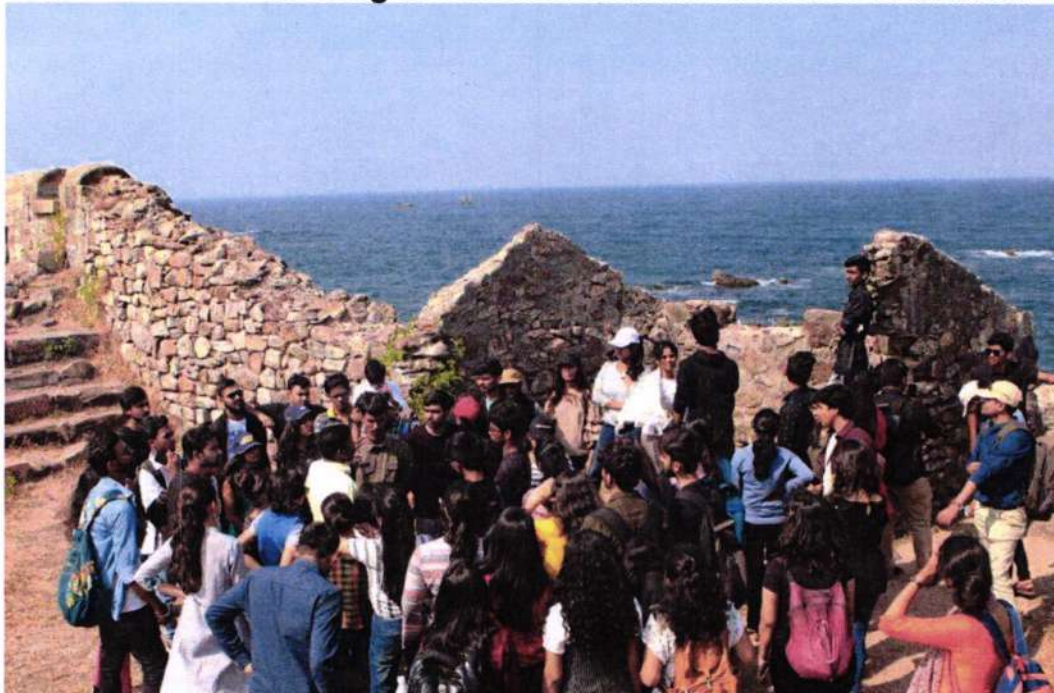

The richness in detailing, carving and iconography in this semi-urban settlement stands out and confirms its rich cultural ties. The famous handloom fabric of Chanderi has a lot of demand. However, the weavers hardly get benefits of this booming business. Their conditions are deteriorating. The new development proposed by government has attracted a lot of criticism due to its alien nature.</p>

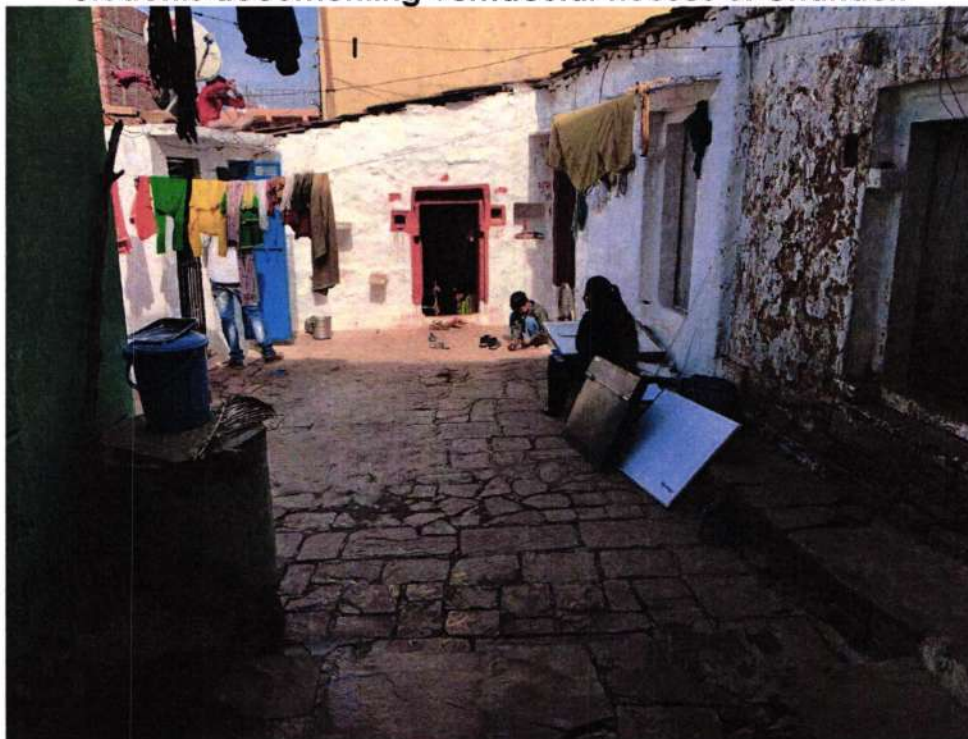

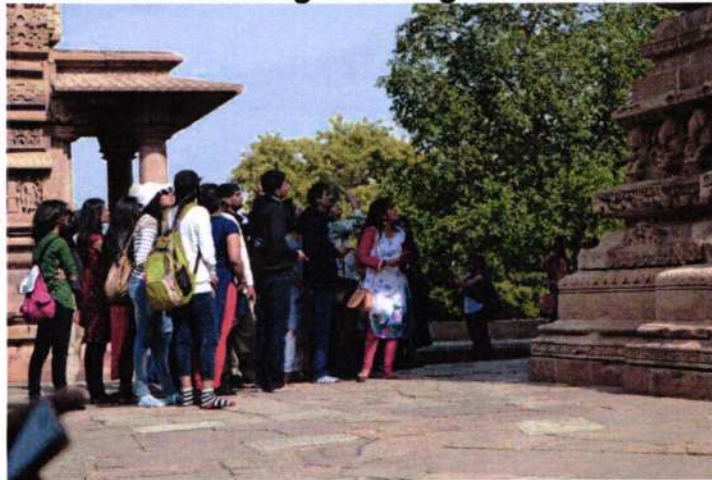

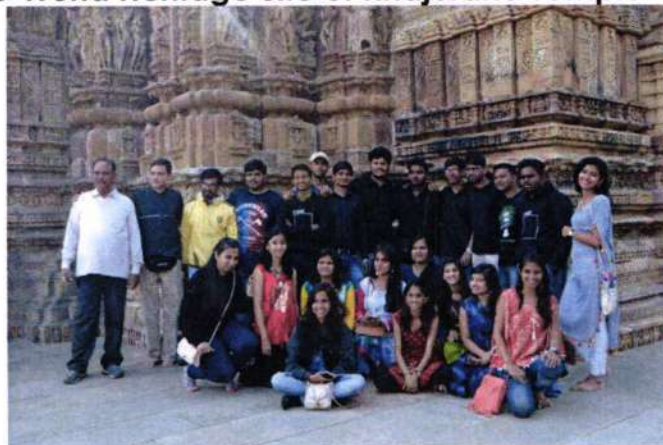

Brief about the (Activity/Event)	<p>The understanding of Architectural vocabulary of Indore was developed by the students through experiences and observations during the settlement study. The study of socioeconomic, cultural aspects, climatic and topographic conditions along with the historical references gave a thorough understanding about the context of the city and present day concerns.</p> <p>Based on this study and analysis, students arrived at a number of design alternatives for building typologies to be taken as the design topic. After series of discussions, the building typology of cultural information centre was extracted after a methodical approach to understand the complexities of urban design and draw conclusions at the 3rd year B.Arch level of understanding.</p> <p>Site selection was based on the strategic location of the site along Saraswati river which is in derelict condition. It was at the junction of convergence of the old and new city. Split site on both banks of the river had two separate settings and land forms. Major chunk of the site was on a road leading to Rajwada and had a traditional and historic setting, flanked by heritage buildings. The other part of the site was on opposite bank of the river and had an access from a road to the city's major industrial area and thus had a modern setting and urban sprawl. Smart city proposal for Indore city proposes the revival, rejuvenation and renewal along the bank of Saraswati river. Taking this into account, integration of the two sites across the river was explored by the students.</p>
Remarks	For third year students, visits to contemporary architectural structures need to be incorporated.

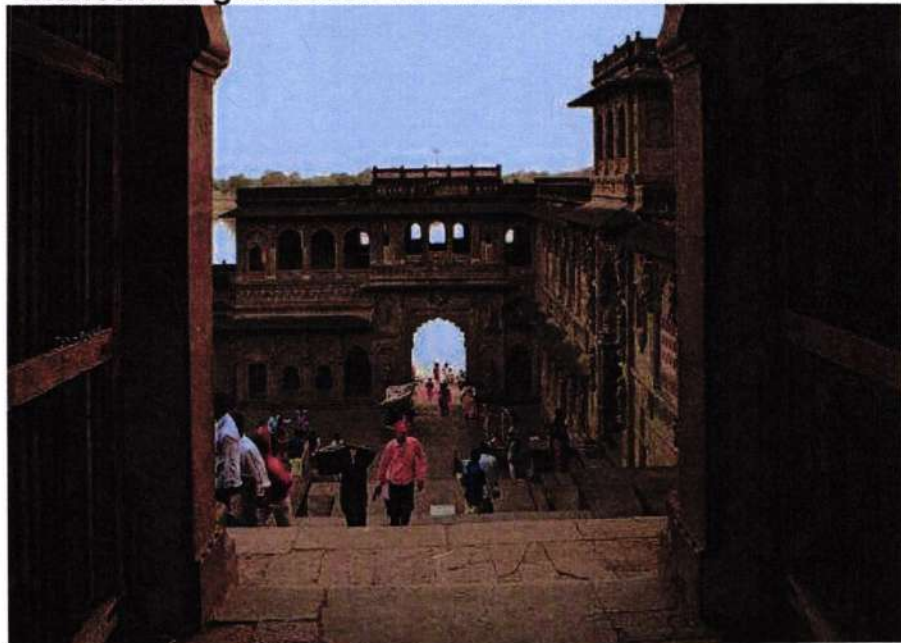

A unique mix of local pilgrims and foreign travellers co-exist in harmony without invading each others sanctity and privacy. Different types of ghats and its adjacent residential cluster and its public interface is documented by second year students.</p>

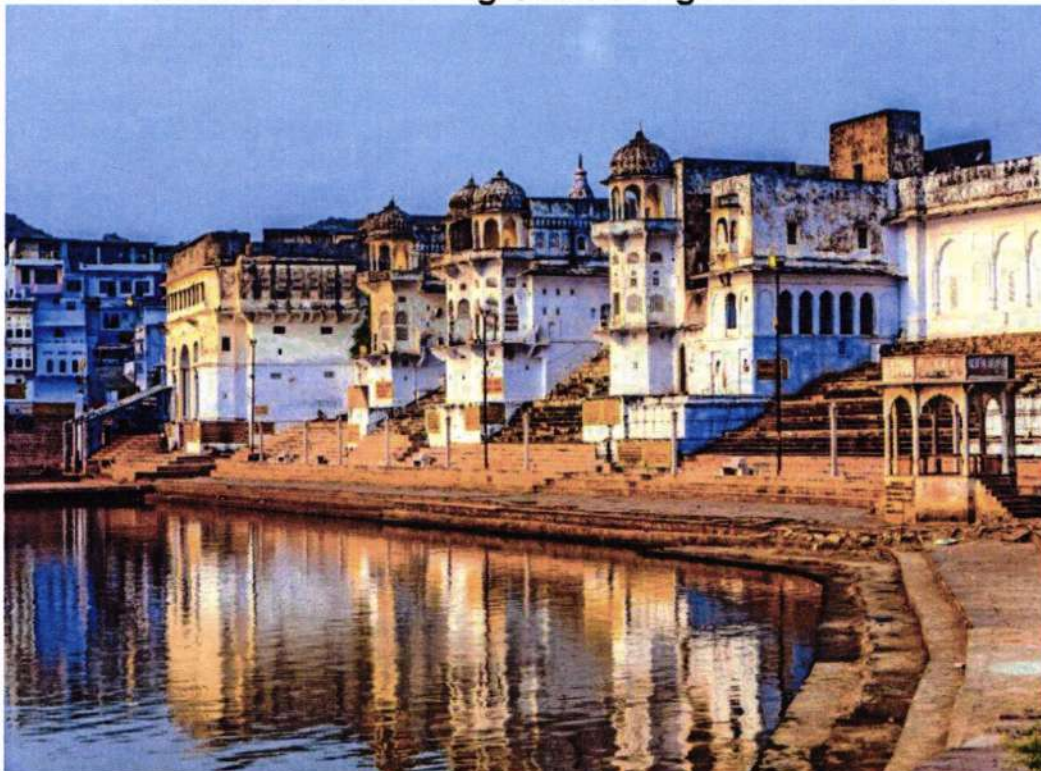

Generally places of historic importance or crafts tradition are chosen. 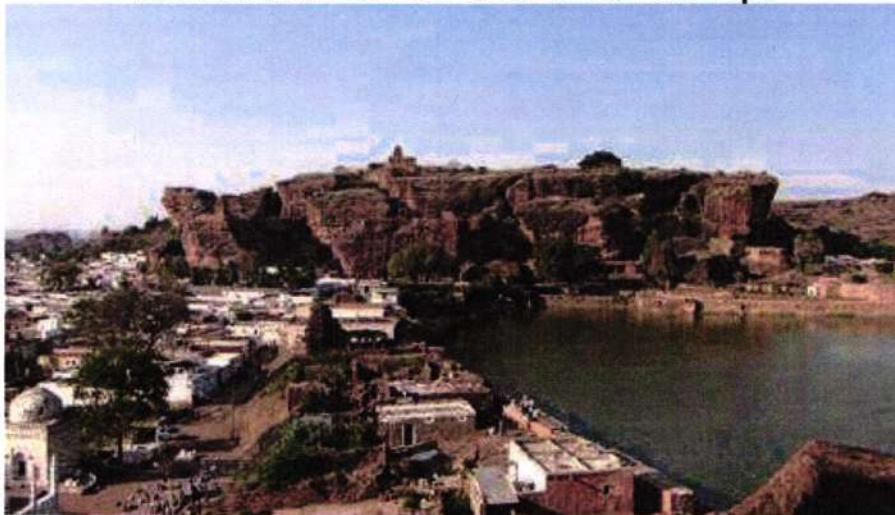
