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B.Des Entrance Exam Paper Specific Instructions 2022-23

1. The examination is of 3 and ½ hours duration. There are in total **7 questions** carrying a total of 150 marks. The paper is divided into three sections, **A, B** and **C**. All sections are compulsory. Questions in each section are of different types.
2. **Section A (20 Marks)** contains a total of **15 MCQ Type** questions – General knowledge Film, Theatre, art, literature, culture, science, maths, sports, current affairs. For each question, the answer is selected from the options provided.
There is **NO NEGATIVE** marking for this section. Each correct answer will be awarded 1 mark. Questions not attempted or with wrong answers will be given zero marks.
A 5 marks question is designed to evaluate the student's command on English language.
3. **Section B (80 Marks)** contains a total of 4 Questions. Each question may have **one or more than one choice(s)**. Out of the given choices, a candidate has to attempt only one choice. There is **NO NEGATIVE** marking for this section. Questions not attempted or with wrong answers will be given zero marks. This section will evaluate the students for the following:
 - Logic Application skills.
 - Critical thinking skills.
 - Problem solving skills.
 - Observation and Drawing skills.
 - Representation and composition skills.
 - Memory and visual recall skills.
 - Imagination Skills
4. **Section C (50 Marks)** contains a total one **Question**. Out of the choice given, the student is expected to attempt making of an object of only one choice. The material to be used is provided by the institute. There is **NO NEGATIVE** marking for this section.
The evaluation criteria consist of idea, making skills, scale and proportions, material understanding and its use.
5. **Section D (50 Marks)** consists of Interview by the panel of the institute. The students must bring the worst portfolio representing their creative, drawing/sketching and visualisation skills.
6. Calculators, charts, graph sheets, tables, cellular phone, smart watches and/or other electronic gadgets are **NOT** allowed in the examination hall.
The students are expected to bring drawing and making material like pencils, pen, eraser, scale, compass, cutter, glue, colouring material, steel scale etc.
7. Papers will be provided for drawing and rough work. Material to make objects will be provided by the institute.
