Revisiting pedagogical objectives of a Design Jury



#### **PREAMBLE**

The design jury, design critique, or crit is a common teaching and learning strategy within art, design, and architecture education. It dates back to the nineteenth century Beaux-Arts school of architecture education and has since evolved into a variety of different formats within architectural education. The aim of the design crit is to provide oral formative or summative feedback, depending on when the crit occurs in relation to the design exercise, and to prepare the students for their careers as professional designers presenting their designs to clients.

There are criticisms on the process of crit as being more negative and not comprehending to heighten the learning atmosphere for student anxiety, students' inability to learn from the feedback, power asymmetry between student and faculty or privileging professional acculturation over student learning. Yet it is universally accepted that Design crit is a distinguishing factor of education so, there arises a need to relook into various methods and techniques of conducting a constructive crit.

 The five day programme would look out to explore various components of a design crit focussing on the learning objectives and outcomes of the level of the design education, studio brief and expected quality of work from the students, relevance of the crit and take away from the comments given, ways to incorporate the jury comments into furthering the design process. The discussions would focus on the crit environs like timing, participants, audience, feedback, purpose, language and location. ET all, the programme would conclude with finding ways to device the process of crit as a conducive method of design pedagogy.

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


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#### 5. Faculty development program

#### Objectives:


- 1. To develop, promote and enrich the teaching learning process.
