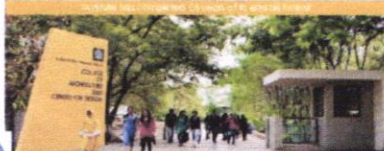

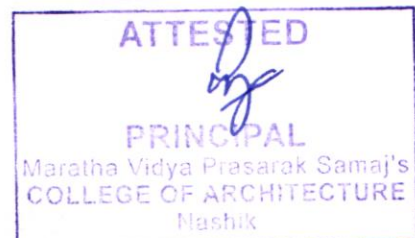
INAGUARATION BY THE HONDS OF PRAFULLA SAWANT AND RAJESH SAWANT

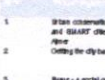

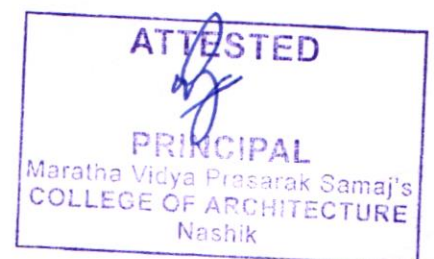

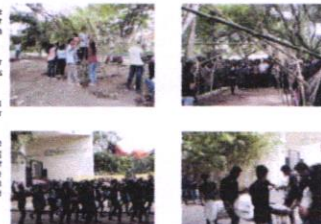
EXTRA CURRICULAR 1ST SEPTEMBER 2016 COLLEGE DAY

On the occasion a structure is erected by the students of 1st year B.Arch and B.Des.

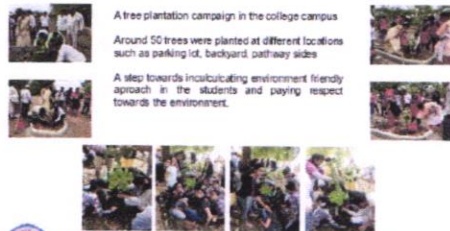
This year the students created a semi covered gateway using bamboo and ropes that symbolized the journey of the students from previous batches till now that brought name, fame and glory to the institute.

A tree plantation campaign in the college campus

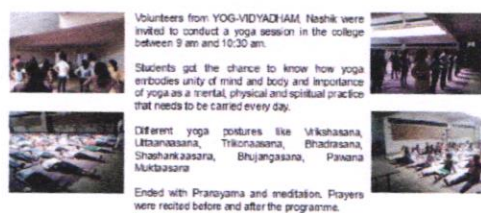
Around 50 trees were planted at different locations such as parking lot, backyard, pathway sides
