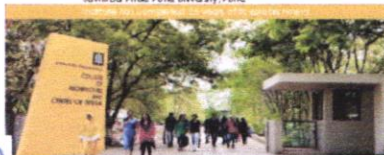

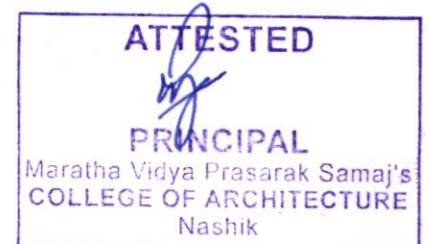
"Co-existence with Nature"

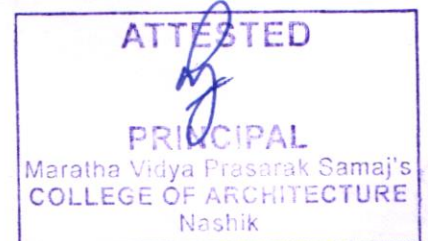

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CO-CURRICULAR GUEST LECTURE ON WATER SUPPLY SYSTEMS BY MR. MILIND SHETE

Day : Wednesday, 16th Aug 2017

As a part of academic curriculum of the subject Building Services for second year B.Arch, Mr. Milind Shete was invited as a guest lecturer. Mr. Shete is a chairman of Indian Plumbing Association, Nashik Chapter and has a vast experience in working as a plumbing consultant. He enriched the students with the in-depth knowledge of water supply systems for residential buildings, prerequisites for water supply fittings and fixtures, advancements in the field of plumbing and issues related to the water supply system design in its execution. The session was accompanied by the faculty, Prof. Giranjalal Prof. Jitendra, Prof. Shantaram Jaywale, Prof. Satish Manohar and Prof. Anil Patil. Mr. Shete demonstrated his own projects with interactive graphics and photographs that made students understand the concepts in more practical way.



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CO-CURRICULAR DESIGN TALK BY SHAILESH RAJPUT

Day : 7 Feb 2018

Shailesh Rajput a product designer and alumni of M.V.P.S.'s College of Architecture and Centre for Design, Nashik, interacted with first, second year architecture and product design students. Shailesh Rajput is a Principal Designer of Shailesh Rajput Studio that specialises in bespoke lighting installations, lifestyle furniture, sculptures, wall mounts & installations in hand blown glass, brass, and copper. Through demonstration of his own projects he explained the concept of form, function and interoperability to the students in a very informal way. He had an open dialogue with the students where he shared his journey from a student to a professional. Shailesh Rajput inspired students to put life and soul into everything they create which would lead them to create good designs. Students also interacted with the designer to enrich their knowledge on design process, inspiration, difficulties etc. The overall talk was useful for the faculty as well to understand the students' psyche while guiding them for design. Prof. Ketan Manohar, Prof. Gourav Arora, Prof. Lata Chakraborty and Prof. Pooja Patil attended the talk.



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CO-CURRICULAR VISUAL COMMUNICATION AND GRAPHICS

Day : Feb and March 2018

Under the subject 'Visual Communication' for first year B.Arch course, this year an effort was taken to develop soft skills and graphical language of the students which would be essential and helpful for their academics and profession. For this purpose Mr. Pratikchandra from 'Skyline', 3D graphics training institute, Nashik, was invited to conduct lectures and practice sessions for the students under his supervision. The sessions were targeted on application of graphic softwares like Sketchup, Vray, Rhino and Photoshop for architectural 3D modeling, rendering and presentation techniques in shorter time for better output. The activity was co-ordinated by Prof. Satish Manohar to have 10 sessions of 2 hours each. The activity resulted in improved graphical presentation by the students in terms of 3D architectural drawing, 3D modeling with material applications, human and landscape characters, light effects etc., improved their compositions with appropriate font size, better quality images, backgrounds, innovative home plates etc.



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CO-CURRICULAR ART AND CRAFT INSTALLATIONS

Day : 27th & 28th Dec 2017

As a part of Design studio, first year B.Arch students explored symbolic relationship between different art, craft and architecture by creating live site installations in the form of screens in the college campus in accordance with the Institute philosophy of 'Learning by doing'. The activity aimed at comprehending the symbolic relation between creativity, art, craft, environment, human social experience, structure with design. Students first did background study of the given art and craft forms, viz. cone craft, wool painting, kuchipudi dance, pottery, bandhavwadi etc. in groups and then physically encephalic and screens to have an expression of the particular art form in the given space by understanding special quality. The materials explored included bamboo, ropes, paper, paper dishes, used CD's, corrugated sheets, metal wires, clay products etc. The activity was carried out by the students with great enthusiasm and was guided by the first year Design faculties to encourage teamwork, analytical skills, confidence building etc. within the first year students.

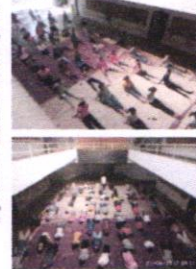


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EXTRA CURRICULAR WORLD YOGA DAY

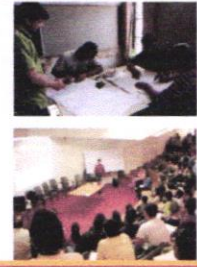

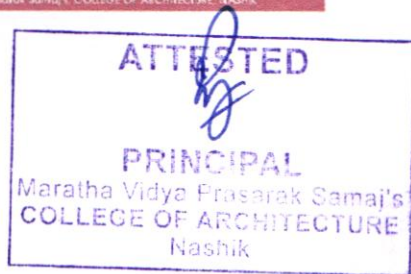


SOCIAL INITIATIVES BUS STOP UPGRADATION

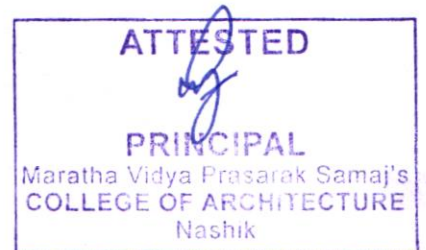
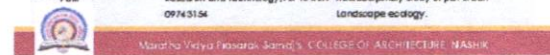
