

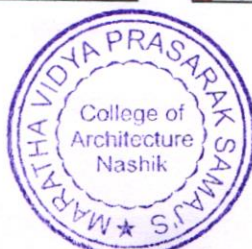

The intention of the elective is to make students learn fundamental concepts that underlie the use of a GIS. Architect Jyoti Jain taught the basics of GIS, its application in the field. Students got the know-how of GIS and its application in architecture and urban design. They worked on the software for hands on experience of applying GIS for an urban issue identified in the city and develop a GIS methodology to generate and analyse data. There were 2 individual assignments and 2 group assignments along with 1 a certificate base online assignment as completion of an online course on GIS.

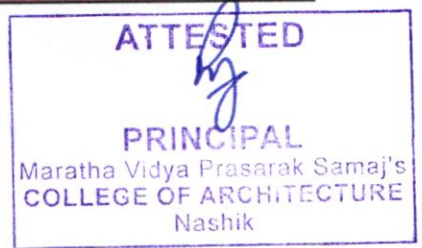
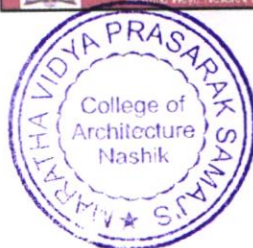
**MAHATMA GANDHI 150<sup>th</sup> JYANTI POSTER MAKING COMPETITION**

The facade selected modern architectural is possible with bamboo which is generally boiled upon as a vernacular material. The parametric facade consisted of 36 modules made from bamboo frames. The frames were joined together by strips of sliced bamboo of various lengths that gave it a dynamic and parametric form.

On the last day of the workshop, the students used the technique learned for a small 4' x 4' module on a larger scale to make a hyperbolic pavilion of 20' X 20'. The pavilion consisted of 8 triangular frames which were joined together by self-ball system and supported by bamboo props. As the dried sliced bamboo were filled, the props could be removed. The pavilion is proposed to be used as an outdoor seating area for the students. The pavilion will be incorporated in the campus which is proposed in the campus.


The workshop was coordinated by Ar. Jitendra Kulkarni and the second year design team consisting of Ar. Parag Thakur, Ar. Saan Eadani, Ar. Gaurav Arbooj, Ar. Hemant Thakore, Ar. Jai Sobnis and Ar. Yusuf Hoshikawa. Other faculty members like Ar. Shantappa Langade and B. Anil Thombare also guided the students.



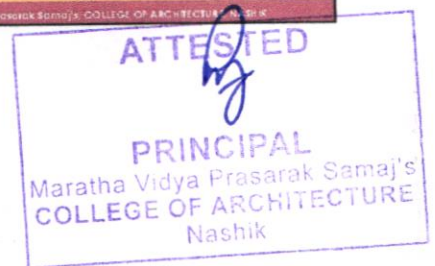
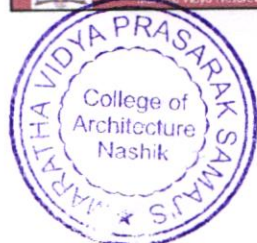

The modules required for the dome were to be made using bamboo sections joined by steel plates. The various tasks of cutting the bamboo to appropriate lengths with precision, cutting steel plates, cutting holes in the plates and stitching them together was allocated to different groups of students. Finally after the preparation was done, the assembly of the geodesic dome was completed.

Anthropometry plays an important role in clothing design, ergonomics, and architecture where statistical data about the distribution of body dimensions in the population are used to optimize products. The objective of the exercise was to make the first year students aware of human dimensions and its relation to various functions along with the standard proportion systems. In the first part of this exercise students were made to measure their hands for human dimensions of specific given postures. This enabled them to arrive at highest, lowest, and mean value of the future measurements for all the postures. 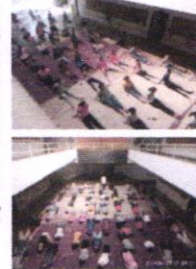
## EXTRA CURRICULAR 'MISTURA' AN ART FEST Day : 23rd to 25th Dec 2017

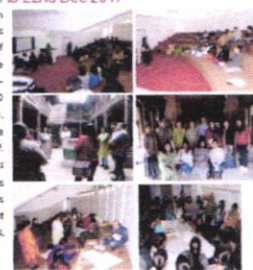

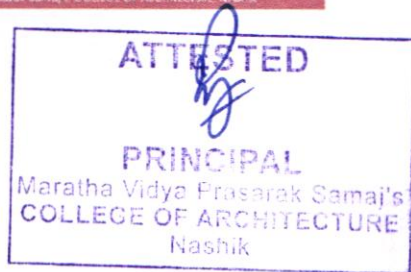


### SOCIAL INITIATIVES BUS STOP UPGRADATION

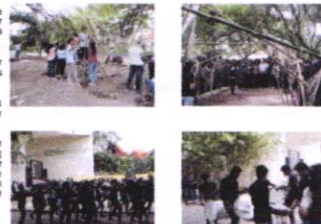
## EXTRA CURRICULAR 1<sup>ST</sup> SEPTEMBER 2016 COLLEGE DAY

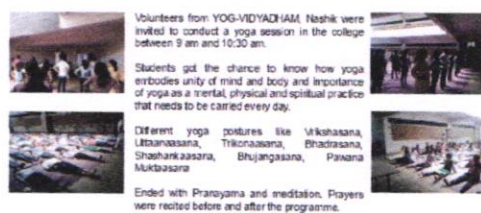

World Yoga day celebration on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2014



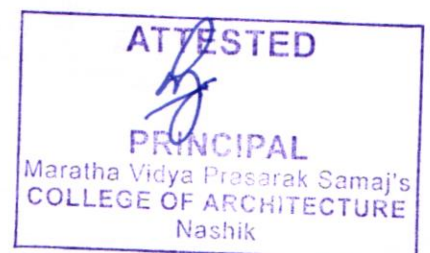
Volunteers from YOG-VIDYADHAM, Nashik were invited to conduct a yoga session in the college between 9 am and 10:30 am.
