IQAC Annual Report 2022-23

Date – 20.07.2023

IQAC initiatives for the tear AY 2022-23 included increasing the MOU's with other Academic Institutes, strengthening and widening the scope of Academic monitoring committee (AMC) and identifying real time issues of the city and propose solutions.

The following initiatives taken by IQAC during the curriculum conduction.

1. Certificate courses

Certificate Courses conducted are as follows:-

“2D Architectural drawings presentation and introduction to Autocad 3D” course was conducted in 2 batches. Each was a 30 hours batch with 3 hours expert lecture and 2 hours of practical training.

“Heritage Documentation- Step-well Documentation” was conducted by college on 1st, 2nd, 4th and 7th April 2023. The aim was to expose the students to onsite documentation techniques.

Soft skill development training session for the non-teaching of the Institute was conducted on 14th January 2023. The purpose of the training session was to improve skills in Microsoft Excel and ERP system.

2. Academic Collaboration and Workshop

An academic collaboration with RVS Chennai Padmavathy School of Architecture and MVPS's COA, Nashik was conducted for 3rd Year B.Arch Architectural Design V subject from 2nd February to 7th February 2023. A collaborative studio was conducted to exchange ideas, experiences and skill sets amongst the peer members. “Decoding High –rise structures” was the topic where students will experience a vision to understand the planning, construction and execution of High rise buildings by identifying case studies.



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3. Real time problems

To Develop the Professional Competency, to let know the challenges in the profession, and to accomplish the mission of serving the society through academic conduct; “Real-time Issue-based Student Projects” were identified and incorporated in subjects like Urban Studies, Architectural Design, Electives, Research in Architecture. The students strive and develop a realistic approach in seeking the solutions.

Following real time problems were taken:

For 4th year Urban studies the focused on traffic and tourism development of Nashik and planning for Future Infrastructure, Metro network and Urban development in Nashik.

For 4th year Elective subject, Public Park revitalization competition was competition organized by IID Nashik.

For 4th year Elective, designing of a memorial for Ar. Charles Correa in Pune.

For 4th year Elective, INSDAG steel design competition of Multi event stadium at Jharkhand and R&D Centre at Vishakhapatnam.

For 2nd Year real time problem as an Architectural Design competition was taken of School Design and Maruti temple design.

1st Year had taken up Designing of an Ayurvedic Treatment Centre at Mokhamal as a real time problem for Architectural Design.

4. State level QIP on MOOC's training organized by SPPU, Pune

4 faculty members along with Librarian attended a 2 day training session organized by SPPU at Dr. BNCA, Pune. The objective of this training session was to understand about MOOC's Massive open online courses: Design and development, usage in Architectural Frame work and its implementation at our Institute.



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5. NSS activities

NSS camp and extension activities were organized to expose the students to the community needs and problems, identify the problem solve it and develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibilities. Following activities were conducted:

“Sapling Donation Drive” was conducted by NSS on 2nd September 2022 at MVPS’S COA, Nashik. The objective was to create awareness amongst young minds about the environment. 40 nos. of students participated in this activity.

“NSS Tree Plantation Campaign” was conducted on 3rd September 2022 at Fashicha Dongar, Nashik. 30 students participated in this activity.

6. Participation of students in the Competitions for society and need based proposals for the same.

“Revitalizing Urban Open Spaces Competition” was organized by IIID Nashik Chapter where 6 students were selected as winners.
